Previously, Tucker served in various student roles from August 2012 until his graduation as Production Manager in December 2014. He joined Carrollton based Gradick Communications in July of 2015, and can be heard on WCKS Kiss 102.7 from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. every Saturday. Tucker’s skills also include audio board operations for fall high school football and various remote broadcasts on B92 Country and Great Classics 98.9 FM. “It feels great to be back with the family that made me who I am, and to have the opportunity to hopefully do the same with other students,” said Tucker.
